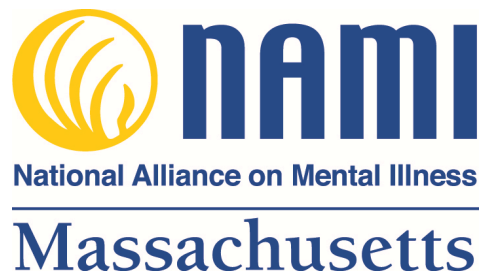

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Methodology

On behalf of the Massachusetts chapter of the National Alliance on Mental Illness, Marttila Strategies conducted a telephone survey of 800 Massachusetts voters. The survey is a representative sample of Massachusetts voters.

For those questions that were answered by 800 respondents, the survey has a margin of error of +/-3.46 percent. For some questions, the survey used the technique of “split sampling,” a process in which the 800 respondent sample was split into two demographically representative samples of 400 respondents. For questions answered by 400 respondents, the survey has a margin of error of +/- 4.9 percent.

The purpose of split sampling in the survey was to maximize the number of questions that could be asked, to test different hypotheses about an issue, and to test the impact of different question wording.
